In June 2016, at the request of the Association of Lithuanian Serials, the national ISSN Agency supplied the list of academic periodicals registered in Lithuania stating their ISSN identifiers and additional information from the LIBIS system of the National Bibliographic Database. Continuing publications recorded in the list of academic periodicals presented by the national agency were grouped according to the following criteria: Publisher — compiler of the latest publication volumes, i.e. a university or its representative named in LIBIS or PDF file or otherwise, but not the institution that ordered ISSN. Type of publication: Scientific journal — peer-reviewed scholarly publication having a certain periodicity and ISSN. At this stage of the study, as research collections have no periodicity yet are referred to as scientific journals in the website of the publication, PDF file, website of the publisher and other Internet sources,
